Registration Information

Each of our 4 school sites will be enrolling students in office for the Spring 2017 semester. Be sure to double check the location of the course you wish to attend prior to going to the school site.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Multilevel or multi-semester courses have been given priority registration to allow current students to enroll for the next level without interruption to the course curriculum.
- Enrollment for these courses may not be available for the Spring 2017 semester.
- Building Maintenance and Repair will only be available to students currently enrolled in the Level one session. Enrollment for the Level 1 session will be available again in Fall 2017 semester.

** Building Maintenance & Repair and Living Online at Chula Vista Adult School WILL NOT be available for enrollment for Spring 2017 semester.

New Students (Veteran Education Program)

Due to new reporting requirements from VA, New Student enrollment for courses through the Veteran Education Program will not be available for the Spring 2017 semester. New student enrollment will resume for the Fall 2017 semester (July) and orientations will be available in April 2017. Full schedule will be available in March. This applies also to students who have attended in the past but are not currently attending for the Fall semester.

Work Study Students: You must submit Work Study Supervisor Contact Information at the time you submit enrollment information if you are requesting expedited certification. If this information is not submitted, your file will be processed in the order in which it was received.

- **Culinary Arts – Cake Designs, Chocolate, and High End Decoration Techniques** (1 semester course) – Enrollment available to current Level 1 Pastry students only.
