Re: Lottery Results

The second lottery for veteran students to enroll in G.I. Bill-approved classes was held on September 17, 2018. It was announced prior to the lottery that there were 89 openings anticipated for new veteran enrollments in the spring 2019 semester.

Due to unforeseen human error, 14 slips of paper were not included in the lottery box. Therefore, these 14 students did not have a fair opportunity to be approved for a class.

To amend this situation, a supplemental lottery will be held Thursday, September 20, 2018. This lottery will be conducted during the Sweetwater-Veterans Alliance meeting on Thursday, 9/20, at 2:00 pm at National City Adult School, 517 Mile of Cars Way, National City, CA 91950.

The supplemental lottery will be held using the names of the 14 students not included in the lottery, and 570 numerical placeholders (#'s 1-570, the same number of names pulled in the lottery on 9/17/18). The names of **students already selected WILL NOT be included** in the supplemental lottery! The supplemental lottery will be conducted using Random.org, which will generate a random lottery-type list of results that will include the 570 numbers and the 14 names. The 14 names of students will be placed into the lottery results from 9/17/18 in the place where their name is drawn by random.org on 9/20/18. For example, if a student is drawn 15th in the random.org lottery on 9/20/18, they will be placed in the 15th slot in the 9/17/18 public lottery results list.

To ensure that no student who was selected early in the 9/17/18 lottery loses their classroom seat as a result of this human error, the adult school program will increase the number of seats in G.I. Bill-approved classes from 89 to 103.
