

General Information

Adult education classes offer students an opportunity to continue their education in basic skills, high school, or post-secondary school levels suitable for adults. They are fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC), and adult school graduates are eligible to be admitted to colleges and universities.

REGISTRATION

Most classes are free for U.S. residents 18 years of age or older. New enrollments are accepted at any time in many classes. If you have a question regarding registration, please call your local adult school (Chula Vista Adult, Montgomery Adult, National City Adult, San Ysidro Adult).

Students who wish to attend Adult Literacy and ESL classes must go to the appropriate adult school office to enroll.

EARN COLLEGE CREDIT

Complete certain adult school courses and earn college credit. When you are ready to enroll at Southwestern College you receive credit, avoid repeating courses, and take more advanced classes.

CERTIFICATES OF PROFICIENCY

Certificates are issued in typing, and all Career Technical Education (CTE) classes. This document may be presented to employers to verify training and skills.

CLASS FEE

Fees are charged for supplies, and/or materials. The amount of the class fee will be indicated for each class. There are no refunds unless the class is cancelled.

NON-RESIDENT CHARGE

Non-residents must pay the established hourly non-resident charge of \$6.31 per hour of instruction.

GED

Examinees must be at least 18 years old. To register go online to www.GED.com or call 1-877-392-6433. There are four tests, each cost \$35. The first two retest are \$15, the third retest returns to \$35. All test fees are handled through Pearson VUE at the time of scheduling. Special testing arrangements may be made for the hearing or visually impaired, for the certifiably learning disabled, and for those with other handicaps.

HiSET

Examinees must be at least 18 years old. There are five tests: Writing, Reading, Math, Science and Social Studies. Accommodations are available for individuals with documented disabilities. Exams are offered on paper and/or computer.

Examinees must first create a HiSET account at http://hiset.ets.org/test_takers/. Registration is done in person at Chula Vista Adult School.

Please bring you HiSET ID#, payment and valid government issued ID (State ID, Driver's License, Passport, or Military ID).
